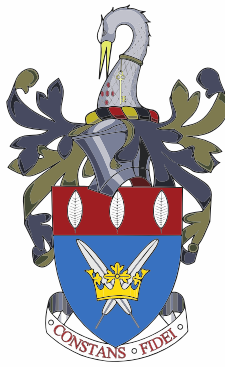

### SCHOOL BREAKFAST CLUB

Breakfast Club is run by school support staff and a member of the Hull Catering team. It is held in the dining hall and runs from 8.00am to 8.45am with the last breakfast served at 8.30am. **No child will be admitted to the club after 8.30am.** There is a charge of £1.50 per day to be paid onto your child's ParentPay Breakfast Club account. Children who are in receipt of benefits-related free school meals can attend the breakfast club free of charge.

Breakfast will consist of:

- cereal
- milk
- toast & jam or marmalade

After eating breakfast children are provided with different play activities and are then be escorted to their classes at 8.45am ready for school starting at 8.50am.

**Please be aware that attendance at this club is a privilege, not a right and a child's attendance will be dependent on them showing the same standard of good behaviour that we expect at any other time in school. If a child is unable to meet this standard they will not be allowed to attend.**

#### Entry to the Breakfast Club

Entry to the Breakfast Club is through the main school reception entrance.

#### Car Parking

Please could I remind you that, except in exceptional circumstances, (e.g. for a parent or a child with a disability), **the car park is for staff use only** - unfortunately we don't have room for anyone else. There have been several 'near misses' both for cars and children. There is a car park that you can use on Lorenzo's Way (next to St. Aidan's Church) and a footpath to the school.

#### Coats and Bags


The cloakroom directly adjacent to the dining hall door which the children use for Breakfast Club should be used for coats, wellingtons etc. Children should bring their bags into the dining hall so that valuables such as dinner money are safe.

Just as for any other part of the school day, a first aider will be present in school and should your child feel unwell or hurt themselves they will contact you using your emergency contact details.

If you would like your child to attend you **must** complete and sign the form on the reverse of this letter and get it back to us here at school at least the day **before** the first time your child attends the Breakfast Club.
