Breakfast Club – New Booking System

Please be aware that we are now introducing a booking system for Breakfast Club. As of Monday 5th October we are asking for all parents who wish to book their children into Breakfast Club to contact the school office on 01482 376203 to book the sessions on a fortnightly basis. This means that your child's sessions for Breakfast Club for the week commencing Monday 12th October will have had to be booked using the new booking system.

You will have a full week to book your child into the Breakfast Club but you must book for the following 2 weeks sessions. Please be aware that there are only 25 spaces allocated so it will be a first come, first served basis. We will not be allowing any more children into the Breakfast Club once we have reached our capacity. This is to ensure numbers in the club are in-line with our current risk assessment.
