Our Weekly Music Teaching Offer

Every child receives up to 1 hour of Music teaching a week in our school - it is a spiral, multi-sensory and well sequenced curriculum designed for Alderman Cogan's needs. All pupils - attend our 30 minute whole-school music assembly once a week delivered by our Music Specialist - Listening and Singing. The whole school also receive termly Whole Class Ensemble (brass, strings) by Hull Music Service.

- **EYFS pupils** - receive a 20 minute music lesson using Kapow and sing traditional rhyme and song with lots of opportunities to explore instruments, sing and perform.
- **KS1 pupils** - receive a 45 min Music lesson using Kapow using a sequenced lesson-by-lesson progression. Children will use a range of untuned percussion, singing, composing and music games.
- **KS2 pupils** - receive a 1 hour Music lesson with Hull Music Service. Children explore the full range of musical dimensions and have opportunities to play instruments Y4 Pbuzz, Y5 trombone and revisit tuned and untuned percussion. Year 3 and Year 6 will take part in Choral Singing and perform. All classes do listening using the MMC, performing, composing & singing too.

Our Music Assemblies

Our Music Assemblies Delivered by our T&L staff, all of our pupils access our weekly 20 minute music assembly with a focus on 'Singing and listening'. Children listen to music from a range of genres, time periods and locations all around the world (adapted from the Model Music Curriculum). We use this as time to come together and sing. We also use the time to help our children prepare for our calendar of performances events.

All of our children have the option to choose and learn to play an instrument with specialist brass teachers from Hull Music Service and through Rock Steady

- ★ **Autumn Term:** Harvest Festival , Carols Service on the playground. Choir perform out in the community and Hull City Hall.
- ★ **Spring Term:** Choir Perform at Sheffield Arena, Easter service at Church. Year 3 perform as part of Choral Music.
- ★ **Summer Term:** Year 4 & 5 perform at Hull Bonus Arena. Year 6 perform as part of Choral Music. Year 6 end of term production and singing.
